The overall objective of the project is to improve sanitation and Hygiene practices and access to safe water for targeted districts in Northern Uganda including Amuru, Gulu, Kitgum and Pader by January 2012.

## Key Outcomes

1. Improved access to safe water for targeted returning communities in Northern Uganda
2. Improved sanitation and hygiene practices among targeted returning communities in Northern Uganda.

## Key Project Activities

- Construction of 28 boreholes
- Rehabilitation and repair of 16 boreholes
- Construction/installation of 16 rain water harvesting tanks
- Construction of 16 blocks of latrines in schools
- Support community/household latrine construction in 8 model villages
- Hygiene and sanitation awareness in 8 schools and 8 communities
- Support schools sanitation and Hygiene health clubs in 8 schools in order to promote good sanitation practices
- Support to district technical staff on hygiene awareness
